Future simple 'Will'	Will + infinitive	 Action decided at the time of speaking (not a plan) 	It's too hot - I'll open the window.
		Future Predictions First Conditional	In ten years all cars will be electric. If the sun shines, I'll go for a walk.
Future Continuous	Will + be + Verb - 'ing'	Action in progress at a particular time in the future	I will be sleeping at 2 a.m.
Future Perfect	Will + have + Past participle	Action will be finished before another action or time in the future	We will have eaten dinner when you arrive.
Future Perfect Continuous	Will + have + been + verb - 'ing'	Duration of a future action up to another future action or time	At the end of this year, we will have been living in Ireland for 3 years.
To be going to	To be + going to + infinitive	 Future plans and intentions Predictions when we see evidence 	I'm going to buy a new car next month. Look at the clouds. It's going to rain soon.
